WARM WEATHER

Warmer weather is on the way – hopefully sooner than later! Please be reminded of the following -- to ensure the summer weather enjoyment of all Mercer Park Residents.

- 1) Neighboring windows are likely to be open please be mindful of noise levels and community quiet hours of 10 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- 2) Please do not allow pets unattended access to patio and/or entry areas it is often in their nature to bark at outdoor activity.
- 3) Propane and electric barbecues are permitted no charcoal barbecues, liquid fire starter or open flame devices (i.e. tiki torches, fire pits, candles) are prohibited on the premises. Please ensure barbecues are moved away from siding when in use.
- 4) Window air conditioners are permitted Memorial Day through Labor Day with Board approval. Submit your approval request, containing unit specifications and installation plan, to Management prior to installation.
- 5) Skateboards, rollerblades and scooters are not permitted on the premises, except for ingress and egress to and from the property.
- 6) 2nd & 3rd level units please alert lower level units prior to washing deck/entry areas as water will splash onto their decks/entries.
- 7) 2nd & 3rd level units if you are watering plants in the front entry please check that drain at lower level entry is not covered or clogged.
- 8) Please do not feed the birds, squirrels and other wild life their feed attracts/multiplies the number of mice and rats on-site.
- 9) Please use caution and observe posted speed limit (10 MPH) our neighbors, their children and guests are far more likely to be out doors during the good weather.
